read at home. As an added educational tool, the surgeon may request specific 3D animated narratives be emailed to you for viewing at home. The patient will receive an email from 3D-Eye Home with links to the prescribed animated narratives. This allows the patient to share the information with family and friends and/or the ability to repeatedly view the

material. It is our belief that patients and their families should have access to the most current educational materials. 3D-Eye offers another means of making the material available to our patients.
